## **INVITATION TO THE OBSERVANCE OF THE LENTEN DISCIPLINE**

ONE: Friends in Christ, every year at the time of the Christian Passover we celebrate our redemption through the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Lent is a time to prepare for this celebration and to renew our life in the paschal mystery. We begin this holy season by acknowledging our need for repentance, and for the mercy and forgiveness proclaimed in the gospel of Jesus Christ.

I invite you, therefore, in the name of Christ, to observe a holy Lent by self-examination and penitence, by prayer and fasting, by works of love, and by reading and meditating on the Word of God. Let us bow before God, our Creator and Redeemer, and confess our sin.

## **PSALM OF CONFESSION**

**Psalm 51**

ONE: Have mercy on me, O God, according to your loving-kindness; in your great compassion blot out my offenses.

**MANY: Wash me through and through from my wickedness and cleanse me from my sin.**

ONE: For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me.

**MANY: Against you only have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight.**

ONE: And so you are justified when you speak and upright in your judgment.

**MANY: Indeed, I have been wicked from my birth, a sinner from my mother's womb.**

ONE: For behold, you look for truth deep within me, and will make me understand wisdom secretly.

**MANY: Purge me from my sin, and I shall be pure; wash me, and I shall be clean indeed.**

ONE: Make me hear of joy and gladness, that the body you have broken may rejoice.

**MANY: Cast me not away from your presence and take not your holy Spirit from me.**

### **PRAYER OF PENITENCE**

ONE: Let us pray.

and our dishonesty in daily life and work,

**MANY: we confess to you, O God.**

ONE: Our negligence in prayer and worship,  
and our failure to commend the faith that is in us,

**MANY: we confess to you, O God.**

ONE: Accept our repentance, O God,  
for the wrongs we have done.  
For our neglect of human need and suffering  
and our indifference to injustice and cruelty,

**MANY: Accept our repentance, O God.**

ONE: For all false judgments,  
for uncharitable thoughts toward our neighbors,  
and for our prejudice and contempt  
toward those who differ from us,

**MANY: Accept our repentance, O God.**

ONE: For our waste and pollution of your creation  
and our lack of concern for those who come after us,

**MANY: Accept our repentance, O God.**

ONE: Restore us, O God,  
and let your anger depart from us.

**MANY: Favorably hear us, O God, for your mercy is great.  
Forgive us, O God, and restore us by your grace. Amen.**


