The cover artwork is an icon of the Holy Trinity by Saint Andrei Rublev (1360s–c. 1430). Little is known about Rublev's life; he probably studied under Theophanes the Greek, with whom he painted several icons and frescoes at the Cathedral of the Annunciation in Moscow. This icon, which came to represent the ideal of Eastern Orthodox iconography, is the only work authenticated as entirely by Rublev.
